Construction standard requested to be waived: OAR 333-061-0050

- (c) When alternate measures are provided which, in the opinion of the Department, will provide adequate protection to the health and safety of the public including the ability to produce water which does not exceed the maximum contaminant levels listed in rule 333-061-0030.

Describe situation that conflicts with the standard. OHA note a road and vehicle parking area within 100-ft of the new well.

Describe why meeting the standard is highly burdensome or impractical. N/A

Describe proposed alternate measure that provide adequate protection to public health and safety. The new well is protected from potential hazmat spills on the adjacent roadway by well vegetated shoulders that provide a buffer between the new well and the roadway. The paved winery access road is also sloped westward toward Hopewell Rd NW away from the new well. A temporary gravel road depicted in Figure 1 was used during construction and will not be used as a parking area. The gravel roadway will only be used for agricultural equipment, or landscape /maintenance access.

Traffic on the paved winery access road is limited to a small number of authorized employee vehicles (daily), periodic delivery vehicles and agricultural equipment during crush (August to October annually).

Designated guest and employee parking areas are located outside the 100-ft setback area as shown on Figure 1.
