#### Describe the situation that conflicts with the standard:

Since the South well does not have the required ownership and radius of control, the water system must attempt to obtain a perpetual restrictive easement for all land within 100 feet of the well. See exhibit A attached.


### Describe why meeting the standard is highly burdensome or impractical:

Attempts to contact ownership of the neighboring property have gone unanswered. Lack of responsiveness or willingness to participate in a perpetual restrictive easement causes indefinite time constraints on the proposed campground development.

# Describe proposed alternate measure that provide adequate protection to public health and safety:

The well is properly constructed in a confined aquifer and is not sensitive to local land use practices.
