RE: Failure to comply with the Notice of Violation and Administrative Order issued on June 6, 2016 and possible civil penalties

On June 6, 2016, the Oregon Health Authority, Public Health Division, Center for Health Protection, (Authority) issued a Notice of Violation and Administrative Order (Order) requiring corrective action at the Locust Mobile Village water system (PWS ID# OR4100524).

Specifically, the Order required you to measure and record the disinfectant concentration in drinking water at the Locust Mobile Village water system and report the information every week beginning on June 13, 2016. As of the date of this letter, disinfectant concentration measurements have not been reported to the Authority and you are now at risk of being assessed civil penalties in the amount of \$50 for every distinct rule violation for every day the Locust Mobile Village water system is in violation of a rule (OAR 333-061-0090).

In the event that the Authority assesses a civil penalty against you, you will be notified in writing and provided an opportunity for a hearing pursuant to the Oregon Administrative Procedures Act (ORS chapter 183).

To avoid being assessed civil penalties, you can immediately complete the Compliance Actions specified in the Order and verify your action with Bill Goss at (541) 966-0900.
