RE: Cancellation of the Bilateral Compliance Agreement between the Oregon Health Authority and Sleepy Hollow Homeowners Association

The Sleepy Hollow Homeowners Association (the Association) entered into a bilateral compliance agreement (BCA) with the Oregon Health Authority, Public Health Division, Center for Health Protection, Drinking Water Services (DWS) on June 12, 2014. In the BCA, the Association agreed to complete activities to ensure compliance at the Sleepy Hollow Phase 1 water system, identified by PWS ID# 4100756.

Specifically, the Association agreed to submit complete construction plans identifying how it would comply with the maximum contaminant level for arsenic no later than October 31, 2014. As of February 1, 2015, the agreed upon activity was not completed according to the terms of the BCA.

Because the Association failed to satisfy the terms of the BCA as agreed upon, the BCA is hereby canceled, and the Association is now at risk of additional enforcement action which may include the assessment of civil penalties as prescribed by OAR 333-061-0090.
