RE: Extension to the Bilateral Compliance Agreement between the Oregon Health Authority and the City of Vale

The City of Vale (City) entered into a bilateral compliance agreement with the Oregon Health Authority, Public Health Division, Center for Health Protection, Drinking Water Services (Authority) on January 22, 2014 in order to ensure compliance at the Vale water system, identified by PWS ID# 4100917.

The agreement set forth actions to be completed by the City to ensure compliance with the maximum contaminant level (MCL) for arsenic at the Vale water system. Specifically, the City agreed to submit complete construction plans to the Authority no later than March 30, 2016 identifying how it would ensure compliance with the MCL for arsenic. The City completed some of the agreed upon activities according to the established timelines but was unable to submit complete construction plans due to circumstances beyond its control.

Based on the progress to satisfy the terms of the agreement, the Authority agrees to an extension of Agreement Activity No. 3 in the agreement as specified below.


TERMS OF THE EXTENSION

- Agreement Activity No. 3: The City agrees to submit complete construction plans to the Authority identifying how it will ensure compliance with the MCL for arsenic at the Vale water system.
 - The construction plans will be submitted to the Authority no later than March 31, 2017.

- The construction plans will meet all the applicable requirements of OAR 333-061-0060 and have sufficient detail to completely and clearly illustrate what will be constructed.
- The Authority and the City agree that this extension supersedes and replaces Agreement Activity No. 3 and does not constitute a waiver, modification, or suspension of any other agreement activity, requirement, or term specified in the in the Bilateral Compliance Agreement effective between the parties on January 22, 2014 after being signed by the Authority.


