RE: Violation of the Notice of Non-Compliance issued on February 11, 2015 and possible civil penalties

On February 11, 2015, the Oregon Health Authority, Public Health Division, Center for Health Protection, Drinking Water Services (Authority) issued an Notice of Non-Compliance to Paul Miller requiring corrective action to be completed at the Totem Village Mobile Home Park (Totem) water system (PWS ID# OR4101171).

Specifically, the Notice required that monitoring for radionuclides be completed no later than April 10, 2015 and monitoring for lead and copper in tap water be completed no later than August 15, 2015. April 10, 2015 has passed without completion of the required monitoring, and PJ Land Company is now at risk of being assessed civil penalties in the amount of \$50 for every distinct rule violation and for every day the Totem water system is in violation of a rule (OAR 333-061-0090).

In the event that DWS assesses a civil penalty against you, you will be notified in writing and provided an opportunity for a hearing pursuant to the Oregon Administrative Procedures Act (ORS chapter 183).

To avoid being assessed civil penalties, you can immediately complete the monitoring requirements specified in the February 11, 2015 letter and verify your action with me at 971-673-0405.
