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Deer Island Heights is a public water system subject to the requirements of Oregon Revised Statutes, Chapter 448, and Oregon Administrative Rules 333-061-0005 through 333-061-0295.

The Oregon Department of Human Services, Public Health Division, Office of Environmental Public Health, Drinking Water Program (Agency) issued a Notice of Intent to Impose Civil Penalty (Notice) on April 23, 2008 to Deer Island Heights Water System for specific violations of the Oregon Drinking Water Quality Act and rules. A request for hearing was not received within the specified period allowed, 20 days from the date the Notice was mailed. The Notice became final by operation of law on May 14, 2008.

The civil penalty in the amount of \$1750.00 was due within ten days of May 14, 2008. The Agency is issuing this notification that Deer Island Heights Water System is now delinquent. Please remit a check in the amount of \$1750.00 for the civil penalty to: DHS - Drinking Water Program, Attn: Marsha Fox, PO Box 14450, Portland, OR 97293-0450. Please make the check out to DHS - Drinking Water Program.

For purposes of ORS 293.229 through 293.233 and ORS 293.250, the amount due is a liquidated debt because it is a civil penalty resulting from a final Notice.

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Pursuant to ORS 293.231 the Agency is required to assign liquidated and delinquent civil penalties to the Department of Revenue, as provided in ORS 293.250, not later than 90 days after April 14, 2008. Reasonable administrative costs, collection costs, attorney's fees, and all other costs and charges necessary for the collection of any amount not paid when due, including but not limited to collection charges assessed by the Department of Revenue may be added to the amount due of \$1750.00.

If payment in full is not received on or before July 14, 2008, the Agency will assign the civil penalty to the Department of Revenue for collection.
