RE: Violation of the Reminder to Monitor issued on April 16, 2015 and possible civil penalties.

On April 16, 2015, the Oregon Health Authority, Public Health Division, Center for Health Protection, Drinking Water Services (Authority) mailed a letter to Richard Rainey requiring corrective action to be completed at the Bonanza-Browne Park water system (PWS ID# OR4105999).

Specifically, the letter required that nitrate monitoring be completed and sample results reported to the Authority no later than May 31, 2015. This date has passed without completion of the required action, and the City of Bonanza is now at risk of being assessed civil penalties in the amount of \$50 for every distinct rule violation and for every day the Bonanza-Browne Park water system is in violation of a rule (OAR 333-061-0090).

In the event that DWS assesses a civil penalty against the City of Bonanza, you will be notified in writing and provided an opportunity for a hearing pursuant to the Oregon Administrative Procedures Act (ORS chapter 183).

To avoid being assessed civil penalties, you can immediately complete the required monitoring and verify your action with Brad Daniels at 971-673-0405.
