Dear Mr. Walter Boles,

This letter is to inform you of the timeframe for correction of the violations specified below at the Walt's Mushroom Camp. When a public water system has unresolved violations for more than 5 months, these violations must then be resolved within 90 days or the water system will be referred for formal enforcement.

The Walt's Mushroom Camp water system has the following violations that must be resolved within 30 days:

**Violation #1:** The water system has not taken quarterly coliform samples. OAR 333-061-0036(6)(a)

**Violation #2:** The water system has not taken yearly nitrate samples. OAR 333-061-0036(2)(d)

**Violation #3:** The water system has not taken an arsenic sample. OAR 333-061-0036(2)(a)

**Violation #4:** The water system has not completed plan review. OAR 333-061-0060(1)

The above violations need to be resolved according to the following compliance schedule:

- 1) The water system must monitor for Coliform and report the results to the state by October 15, 2014. In addition the water system must monitor for Coliform Monthly and report the results to the state by the 10<sup>th</sup> of the month following.
- 2) The water system must monitor for Nitrate and report the results to the state by October 15, 2014

- 3) The water system must monitor for Arsenic and report the results to the state by October 15, 2014
- 4) The water system must complete plan review with the Drinking Water Program. Information on plan review can be found at:
